## INTRODUCTION

The Sultanate of Oman Programme for Cultural and Scientific Cooperation involves a cooperation with countries that have a friendly relation with the Sultanate of Oman.

The programme provides grants covering the tuition fees only of higher undergraduate studies for qualified students who have been residing in the Sultanate of Oman and completed grade 12 or year 13 at one of the Government or private schools in the Sultanate of Oman.

This programme offers scholarships to study at the University of Technology and Applied Sciences, one of the Government higher education institutions.

This guide aims to provide information about the terms & conditions, how to make a competitive application by the relevant deadlines, eligibility criteria and how to accept seat offers.

# FIRST: THE SULTANATE OF OMAN PROGRAMME FOR CULTURAL AND SCIENTIFIC COOPERATION: TERMS & CONDITIONS

- 1- Applicant should be a citizen of one of the brotherly and friendly countries that are members in this program.
- 2- Have been residing in the Sultanate of Oman for a continuous period of **not less than one academic year and should have a residence card** and obtained a general education diploma (GED) or its equivalent from an Omani school or an international school in the Sultanate of Oman.
- 3- Have a general education diploma or its equivalent for the current school year 2023/2024 (recent graduate).
- 4- Not be older than 25 years old or younger than 16 years by the 1st of October in the current school year and should have been born after 01/10/1999.
- 5- Meet the terms & conditions for making a competitive application to the programme as stated in the section comprising courses and criteria.
- 6- Submit an equivalency certificate issued by the Ministry of Education in the Sultanate of Oman in case the student is a holder of an international school qualification.
- 7- If competitively selected abide by the rules and regulations in force in the Ministry of Higher Education, Research and Innovation in the Sultanate of Oman.

#### NOTES

Non-Omani applicants who are born to an Omani mother and a non-Omani father can register and compete in the other programme as Omani applicants.

#### SECOND: ONLINE REGISTRATION: INFORMATION AND SUPPORTING DOCUMENTS

#### FIRST: STUDENTS HOLDING GENERAL EDUCATION DIPLOMA CERTIFICATE:

- The HEAC receives information about applicants who graduated from Oman Government and bilingual schools through the Ministry of Education. Therefore, while registering online, they must ensure that their personal details are accurate and up-to-date. In the event of any error or update, these applicants should refer to the The Center of Educational Assessment and Measurement at the Ministry of Education to make the necessary changes in their personal details.

# SECOND: APPLICANTS STUDYING AT INTERNATIONAL SCHOOLS IN THE SULTANATE OF OMAN:

These applicants must provide their personal data and final grades during online registration using the HEAC portal and they must upload the following supporting documents by the relevant deadline.

- 1- Copy of the final certificate and transcript.
- 2- Equivalency letter issued by the Ministry of Education, Sultanate of Oman (International Certificates).

### THIRD: CALCULATION OF THE COMPETITIVE SCORE (GRADE)

The competitive score is the criterion that defines an applicant position in the list of eligible candidates, based on the average of their achieved grades during the General Education Diploma or equivalent exams, as well as the grades in required subjects. The competitive score of an applicant may vary from one scholarship programme to another depending on their grades in the subjects deemed essential to the course(s) covered by the scholarship.

### THIRD: CALCULATION OF THE COMPETITIVE SCORE (GRADE)

To calculate your competitive score, use the following criterion as a guideline:

Competitive score = (Total sum of grades in required subjects) X 60% or 0.06 +(Total sum of grades of all subjects taken by a student) X 40% or 0.04

# Regiteration and Prefernce Arrangement:

# Student willing to compete on grants should follow the following procedures:

- 1- In order to register as an applicant with **HEAC**, you have to login to **HEAC** website www.heac. gov.om and (create an account by getting username and password) make sure you keep your password in a safe place.
- 2- All applicants must register and select programme prefernces during the specified period and they have to meet the registration deadline.

#### FIFTH: GUIDE TO REGISTRATION & ADMISSIONS

- 3- Applicants should check their personal and contact information, such as name, date of birth, gender, national civil number, etc. If students spot any error(s) with their personal details, they should contact the Directorate Center of Educational Assessment and Measurement at the Ministry of Education on one of the following numbers: (24245831 24255760 24254237 24253711 24255141 24255745).
- 4- Complete your registration by providing all required information and details and make sure that you provide your correct mobile number(s) and e-mail address which would enable HEAC to contact you regardingany any seat offer. It is necessary to provide HEAC with your correct mobile number and email address to receive important messages from HEAC.
- 5- Higher education institutions and the Ministry of Higher Education, Research and Innovation set the standard requirements or criteria for each scholarship programme. You should carefully read these requirements before applying for a specific programme and ensure that you met or are likely to meet the standard requirements for that programme.
- 6- You should rank your programmes in order of personal preference. The **HEAC** system has been designed to competitively shortlist applicants for one of their preferred programmes.
- 7- You are advised to apply for the maximum number of preferred programmes for which you are deemed eligible, and not just limit your options to scholarship programmes with higher or competitive requirements as this would also limit your chances of being competitively selected for a seat offer by **HEAC** electronic system.

#### SEVENTH: ALLOCATION OF SEAT ON SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAMMES

Upon completion of the registration and enterin your options (programmes), HEAC system will sort all programmes as per your programme prefernces.

Places are allocated and offered to applicants according to the "order of merit list": this means that a number of eligible applicants will be offered the option of their highest personal preference depending on their school grades, admission requirements, the number of other competitive candidates and the number of seats available for that particular scholarship programme.

Applicants who have been offered a place will receive an SMS on the mobile number (they used to register with HEAC) on the day of the announcement of allocation results. The messages will show the students' (**Residence Card**) and the code of the programme for which they have been competitively selected.

Please note that SMS is a supporting service and the HEAC is not responsible in case the student does not receive the message. Students shall login to HEAC website to check the programme for which they have been competitively selected.

You will be given a period of time to accept or decline the offer (you have to accept or register during the specified period of time). If the HEAC system does not receive your reply before 02.00 pm (local time in Sultanate of Oman)

on the last day based on the relevant deadline, you will lose your offer of a place and it will automatically be awarded to another qualified applicant on the waiting list and you will have no right to reclaim the offer of place at any given point in time.

# If you wish to accept an offer of a place, you should complete one of the following steps:

- 1- You may accept an offer online through HEAC website **www.heac.gov.om** . You shall after that access to the link below to complete registration procedures.
- 2- Alternatively, you may also accept an offer by sending an **(SMS)** message to **(90190)** containing the letter **(A)** followed by your HEAC number (password). You will then receive a text message, confirming that your acceptance of your seat offer has been received. The message will say: "your acceptance of the offer is successful Please complete the registration procedure at the accepted institution within the specified period via the link mentioned below".
- 3- If you did not receive such message within half an hour after completion of one the above mentioned two steps, then you must visit HEAC website to check if the acceptance of your offer confirmed.













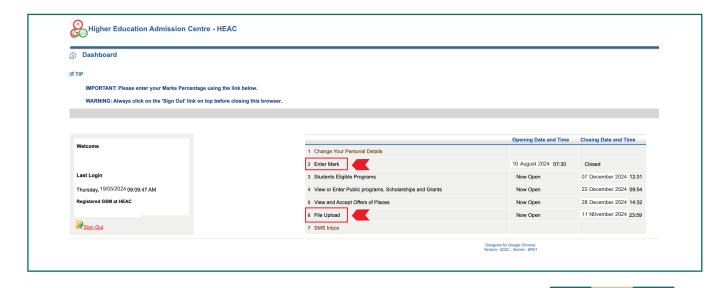

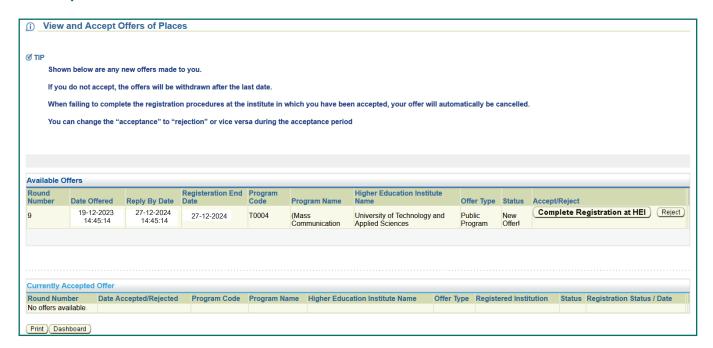

#### **MEDIUM OF INSTRUCTION**

All academic courses at the university are taught in English.

- The student must be medically fit to apply for admission requirements at the University of Technology and Applied Sciences.
- The university offers a range of academic programs in different scientific fields.
- The university offers different academic qualifications levels, such as diploma advanced diploma, or bachelor degree, there for student must be aware of the program he is applying for and the degree awarded by the program.
- All academic programs at the university require a pass in foundation pass in program.
- All accepted students are set for placement of Foundation Program, which is held in the introductory week. Passing the foundation year with its three components is a prerequisite for studying the academic programs at the university.
- The General Foundation Program is an introductory program in some of basic skills required for studying the academic program. The General Foundation Program is not part of the academic program, as it requires student to achieve level of (satisfactory) in the three components: English language, mathematics and computer.
- A student can be excluded from one or all of the GFP components if he passes the GFP challenge exams. Student can submit a valid IELTS certificate at the beginning of the semester provided that its issuence date does not exceed 2 years, and should be issued from a certified center in the Sultanate of Oman or overseas. This certificate may indicate the levels of students or exempt them from studying English subject component while providing a verified copy of academic IELTS certificate with minimum total score of (5), and not less than (4.5) in each skill.
