ADMISSIONS REQUIREMENTS

For acceptance into the MD programme, applicants must meet the following requirements:

- High school qualifications of at least 90% overall score in the final High School Certificate and at least 90% in individual sciences to include Biology and at least one more science
- 2. All students admitted in English undergraduate programmes must submit an English proficiency exam such as IELTS or TOEFL. Our minimum entry requirements for these exams are:

a. IELTS: 6.5 Overall, 6.5 in Writing, and 6.0 in all other Elements

- b. TOEFL iBT: 79 Overall
- 3. Pass MMI Interview either in-person or online

The Medical School offers a one-year foundation programme for students that do not meet Admissions requirements in their first year of application.

The Medical School offers a 6-Year MD degree programme designed for high school leavers. The six-year MD degree is officially listed in the World Directory of Medical School and is an EU-accredited medical degree, which provides licensing and practice pathways worldwide after graduation.

With a 99.8% graduate employment rate, graduating doctors by UNIC Medical School have lent their medical expertise in over 200 medical centres internationally. What is the NCUK International Foundation Year (IFY)?

A gualification designed by NCUK university partners provides students with a foundation year pathway to study and gain your Bachelor's degree in the UK or other countries globally, such as the US, Canada, Australia and New Zealand. The IFY is primarily aimed at international students who have finished high school (such as Thanawiya or IGCSE) and have English language of IELTS 5.0 or equivalent who want to study abroad at university. It is also an excellent pathway to those who wish to improve their British curriculum A-level results.

The IFY qualification meet the highest academic standards set by our university partners. As well as academic knowledge, the NCUK International Foundation Year will give you specialist English language, study and cultural skills that are an essential part of your degree course. This unique combination will help you to get in to the get in to the University of your choice and get on with your future career

What can I study?

Depending on which Bachelor degree students want to study, they can choose one IFY stream. Students will study four subjects related to their stream. English For Academic purposes will be a core subject for all students.

Welcome to OXFORD INTERNATIONAL STUDY CENTRE

Inspiring Education in the heart of the University City of Oxford



- Oxford International Study Centre (OISC) is situated in the very heart of the University city, between the City Hall and Christ Church, Oxford's most famous college. The Study Centre occupies a beautiful and prestigious building which is over four hundred years old, and retains its beamed ceilings and many other original features.
 It is surrounded by the Colleges of the University, and the City has a history of over 1000 years. There are many art collegies and many other original features.
- It is surrounded by the Colleges of the University, and the City has a history of over 1000 years. There are many art galleries and museums, and Oxford is a very musical city, from classical to jazz music. It is in many ways also a young city...there are two universities and a large student population, who enjoy its many cafes, sports and clubs.
- We aim, above all, to support all students in achieving their personal educational goals, through learning in a safe, welcoming, and encouraging environment. Each student has a different personality and learning style, and we pride ourselves on our flexibility, including in the programmes tutorials, seminars and guest lectures.
- Our connections with the University are strong. The Principal and the International Director both studied here, and our students may become members of the Oxford Union and Debating Society, using its libraries and facilities. Many of our summer courses are held in the University, often with guest lecturers from the University.

OUR PROGRAMMES

A-Level (Advanced Level General Certifica e of Education)

We offer full-time exam preparation courses for A-Level with a choice of over 30 subjects , including all Sciences, Maths, Business subjects, Arts and Humanities, Social Sciences, Psychology, and Languages.

Students usually take three of four subjects, often related to their future degree course, eg Physics, Maths and Further Maths for Engineering. We are always happy to advice students before they make their final choice.

The academic year is divided into three terms of 12 weeks, with exams taken in June or July. We are able to offer fast-track A-Level study in some cases, with exams taken after one year's tuition rather than the standard two.

University Foundation Course

Some students prefer to take this programme as an alternative to ALevels. The OISC Foundation programme is recognised by over 20 UK Universities, including Oxford Brookes, which enables students who complete the programme successfully to enter one of these Universities for their degree.

The OISC Foundation programme consists of three elements:

• Chosen academic specialism eg for Business, or for Engineering

• IELTS (Academic English examination for UK Universities)

• Study Skills: researching information, time management ,essay writing and presentation skills. These are all essential skills for studying at University.

IELTS

All students taking either ALevels or Foundation programmes will also take the IELTS exam. This is an Academic English Language exam, needed for entry to UK universities. It consists of Reading, Writing, Listening and Speaking....the four essential skills of all languages.

These courses are intensively focused on the objectives of the exam, rather than more general language learning. We have a %100 pass rate for students taking IELTS preparation courses with us. We usually advise that, with hard work, students can expect to improve their score by between 0.5 and 1.0 IELTS points during each six-month period of study. "From an academic point of view, my English lessons helped to improve my IELTS score, which will be my passport to university, and my A-Level study helped me get a place at the university of my choice. My future definitely looks much brighter now." Cynthia, Angola

Students applying to Oxford or Cambridge During the summer and in the Autumn we assist a number of students in applying to Oxford or Cambridge University. These institutions are unique in holding interviews and specialised entrance tests in November and December. Tuition is at an advanced level, and is individual or in very small groups of two or three students. All tutors involved have a great deal of experience in assisting students in applying to these institutions. In many subjects there are also written tests for example in Law or PPE (Politics, Philosophy and Economics) or Engineering.

Our Summer Programmes

Summer is the most vibrant period of the year at OISC. All our programmes run throughout the year, but during the main summer period (late June to early September) we welcome large numbers of students taking specialised summer courses.

These include:

• Pre-sessional programmes for those about to start ALevels, Foundation, or University undergraduate courses

• English Language , including IELTS preparation

• Oxford and Cambridge admissions preparation

The focus of these courses is on a combined academic and cultural experience, and so most students take a less intensive programme of lessons, to include our cultural activities and excursions programme. This is a great opportunity for students to meet each other, and to make friends from all over the world.



STUDENT WELFARE AND ACCOMMODATION

The welfare and wellbeing of our students, both emotional and physical, is our primary concern. We aim to support all students in learning in a positive, happy environment in which they feel safe and secure at all times. OISC staff have extensive training in safeguarding and are understanding and empathetic listeners. All students are encourage to speak with a member of staff, at any time, if they have any concerns, or if they would simply like some advice. We understand that travelling abroad can be a daunting experience and we do everything we can to make sure students are comfortable and able to study without nerves or stress.

The atmosphere at OISC is a welcoming, warm, and friendly one, where all students feel at home. We operate a robust recruitment procedure, in line with Oxford City Council Safer Recruitment training. All tutors are background checked, referenced, and regularly safeguarding trained. Family members and educational counsellors are encouraged to contact us at any time to discuss our welfare arrangements, or simply for a chat about how their student is getting on. We are always very happy to help!

PASTORAL CARE AND UNIVERSITY SUPPORT

All full-time students at OISC are allocated a personal tutor, with whom they usually meet fortnightly. Additional meetings can of course be arranged in times of need. Personal tutors are responsible for students' welfare throughout their time at OISC, though of course all administrative staff can be consulted by students regarding personal or academic matters at any time. All contact with both personal tutors and other staff is entirely confidential. Personal tutors and academic staff will also assist students with university preparation and the application process where relevant. Progress reports are issued monthly and discussed with each student at these meetings.

ACCOMMODATION

We offer a range of accommodation options to meet each student's preferences and budget. Whilst students who are over 1'8 are very welcome to organise their own accommodation in Oxford, we encourage all students to take up one of the options we offer, to avoid stress, and to ensure a safe living environment. Our Accommodation and Welfare Officer checks all accommodation regularly, and is in constant contact with residence staff, and host families. We liaise closely with parents and counsellors to make sure that we offer the most suitable style of accommodation for each student. All accommodation options include breakfast and an evening meal, with students usually buying their own lunch in the town centre during their break. Accommodation is in single rooms, though students coming to Oxford with friends or family can request to share a twin room if they wish, subject to availability. WiFi is available, free of charge, at all accommodation. We are very happy to offer advice on local hotels, guest houses, or short-let apartments for friends and family who visit students whilst in Oxford. The two main choices of accommodation are the Residence, with private bathrooms, and host families. "The Residence was perfect.
